

# ABOUT THE INDIAN INSTITUTE OF METALS (IIM)

The activities of the institute include organising national and international conferences and programs, conducting qualifying examinations, publications etc. Starting with a modest membership of 42, the IIM membership now stands at more than 10,000 drawn from various fields of metallurgical activities. The institute has grown into a reputed institution and is now recognised throughout the world as one of the premier metallurgical organisations.

The 59<sup>th</sup> National Metallurgists' Day will be organised in February 2022 along with the valedictory function of the institute's platinum jubilee. As a tribute to the important role played by the metallurgists in the country's economic development, the National Metallurgists' Day Awards Scheme, instituted by the Ministry of Steel & Mines, Govt. of India in 1962, presently under the aegis of the Ministry of Steel, Govt. of India, to honour the distinguished Metallurgists of India for their immense contributions, the NMD awards will be conferred during the program. The delegates who will be registering for the November 2021 program, will be automatically registered for the February 2022 program.

# 75<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL TECHNICAL MEETING (ATM)

The Institute is celebrating its 75 years of its service to the nation through a year-long bouquet of events. As a part of the annual event, ATM presentations will be conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of November 2021 in the virtual platform. The scope of ATM encompasses modelling, mineral extraction and beneficiation, manufacturing of Ferrous, Non - Ferrous and other materials, development and characterization of products, environment and other sustainability issues, corrosion, tribology, surface engineering, joining technologies, casting, powder metallurgy, non-destructive testing, emerging technologies, industry automation etc. Students are encouraged to participate in large numbers. The IIM awards for the year 2021 will be conferred during the event.

## INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

An International Conference titled “**Advanced materials manufacturing for sustainable future**” is being organised by the Indian Institute of Metals, which will cover presentations in the area

- (a) Material synthesis/development/design;
- (b) Modern application development and trends and;
- (c) a panel discussion on Sustainability (cradle to grave) covering Ferrous, Non-Ferrous and new advanced materials such as thermoplastics/ thermoset composites/ ceramics.

It would be a one-day online event on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and invited papers will be presented by world renowned academicians, professionals and industry leaders from India and abroad.

## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Abstracts of up to 300 words in length are invited from authors for oral and poster presentation in eight parallel sessions. Online submission of abstracts opened from 7<sup>th</sup> of July 2021. The last date for abstract submission is 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2021.

## METALLOGRAPHY CONTEST

1. Light Microscopy
2. Scanning Electron Microscopy
3. Transmission Electron Microscopy
4. Advanced Techniques (3D Tomography, APT, AFM, SPM, etc.)

The contestants must carefully choose and specify the category of the entry. No reclassification will be done by the contestants afterwards. The micrographs may be in colour or in black and white. Prizes for best metallographs will be decided on the basis of technical content and expertise of the technique. 
